

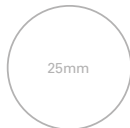
How to measure for Bay Windows

Bay windows are a stunning feature in any home, but often present quite a challenge to dress. We have a specialist team who are here to help you create the perfect solution for your unique window.

All you need do is supply us with a paper template of your window, which is very easy to make. Just follow the simple steps below. (For 90 degrees angles a basic sketch with dimensions will suffice.)

1 Choose your pole diameter

We offer our bay window poles in two diameters, 20mm and a more substantial 25mm option.



2 Choose a finish

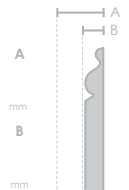
